Arizona Philharmonic is passionate about youth enrichment initiatives and projects. We partner with the Prescott Unified School District (PUSD) each year to offer educational outreach programs. Last year, our project "Discover the Wonder" allowed three third grade classes students to compose their own music after observing and experiencing nature in partnership with the Highlands Center for Natural History. The student's compositions were then performed in the first concert of the 2023 - 2024 Arizona

Philharmonic season. This year, we are collaborating with PUSD once again, with the support of the Acker Trust, for 300 third-grade students to learn how to play recorders, compose music with the guidance of professional teaching artists, and perform their work at a special event with Arizona Philharmonic musicians. Support from donors and community-oriented foundations and trusts enables us to expand our partnership with PUSD, providing enriching music education opportunities to students in our community.

A critical component of Arizona Philharmonic's mission is to enable attendance at all economic levels. Our unique Art4All™ program allows patrons to "donate-what-you-can" towards the ticket price for a concert, ensuring that no community member is ever turned away from our performances simply due to ticket price. Art4All™ allows approximately 150-200 people per year to experience the beauty of a professional concert at an affordable price point. Additionally, our organization partners with VetTix, a program allowing veterans and their families free admission to concerts. We also work alongside local assisted living centers, like Arizona Pioneers' Home, where complimentary tickets for senior citizens are offered to our concerts.

These ticket partnership and accessibility programs are valued at more than \$13,500 annually, relying exclusively on support from community donations and private foundations.
